ETIP Cohort 2023: Student Writing Prompts

ETIP Writing Rubric:

Prompt for Students Entering Grade 2 as of August 1, 2023

In one page or less, the student should answer the questions in their own handwriting:

Part 1: “Share a time when someone or something made you sad. Share why it made you sad and what you did to find happiness again.”

Part 2 Extra Credit (Optional): “Select one of these 4 values and share why that particular value is so important. (Excellence: We strive for excellence; Innovation: We solve problems creatively; Tenacity: We do not give up during trials or hardships; Collaboration: We celebrate each other’s successes – a win for one is a win for all.)”

Prompt for Students Entering Grade 3-4 as of August 2023:

In one page or less, the student should answer the questions in their own handwriting:

Part 1: “Share a time when things did not go your way and how you responded to that challenge.”

Part 2: “Select one of these 4 values and share why that particular value is so important. (Excellence, Innovation, Tenacity, Collaboration).”

Prompt for Students Entering Grade 5-8 as of August 2023:

In 1-2 pages (one page minimum) the student should answer the questions in paragraph form. The short responses should be labeled “Part 1” or “Part 2” on their response sheet.

Part 1: “Share a time when things did not go your way and how you responded to that challenge.

Part 2: “Select one of these 4 values and share why that particular value is so important to you. Then, describe a time when you exhibited one or more of these traits during your academic day and the impact your leadership had on your class, community or peer-group. (Excellence, Innovation, Tenacity, Collaboration)
